Aguilar fifth grade teacher Cassie Schey, along with Chelsea Schell from Thew and Jenny Klein from Fuller, traveled to Germany this past summer as part of the Educator Exchange Program to observe classes and teaching styles for three weeks while living with their host teachers.

Before visiting Germany, Cassie did her homework and learned that German education is based on a tracking system that determines coursework by academic abilities. "While I was there I began to learn the intricacies of their system and the reasons why they chose to implement this method," she said. 
